Aims / General objectives of the European Call for Proposals

The **Erasmus+ Program 2021-2027** introduced new forms of mobility and supports the **Blended Intensive Programmes (BIPs)**.

BIPs have the following objectives:

- Create more opportunities related to "blended" mobilities
- Support the development of innovative ways of learning and teaching
- Stimulate the construction of transnational and multidisciplinary courses

BIPs are **transnational educational paths** that must involve, in the educational design and as beneficiaries, at least three European Universities with ECHE (one coordinator and at least two Partner Universities) from three different **Programme Countries** and at least **fifteen learners from them** (excluding those from the Coordinating University).
